We are excited to share that we currently have openings in our after-school tutoring program devoted to reading or math enrichment for kindergarten through sixth graders that is being offered by Ohio Northern University college students. Tutoring takes place at the Restore Community Center (210 N. Main St, Ada, OH) from 3:30-4:30 PM on Monday and Wednesday afternoons.

As part of this new opportunity, a college student tutor will be paired with your child to work on the development of reading or math skills via the Peer-Assisted Learning Strategies curriculum. Tutors will work with children on increasing reading fluency and comprehension or math. There is **no cost** to you for your involvement in this program. In addition, all tutoring curriculum materials, ability-level appropriate texts, craft supplies, and educational games were covered by an internal grant, which allowed us to start this program last fall.

We ask that parents or primary caregivers agree to arrange for their children's timely transportation to and from Ada Restore each Monday and Wednesday (tutors can be present by 3:15 PM if needed, but children must be picked up by 4:30 PM) and commit to your child being present for each tutoring session (a limited number of excused absences can be accommodated).
